WHAT IS PREP 4 PRESCHOOL?

Learning Links early intervention playgroup provides a relaxed, safe and engaging environment where play activities are tailored to enhance the development of your child. Our professional and experienced Early Childhood Educators and Therapists provide developmental information and guided support to help your child communicate, learn and play in preparation for a smooth transition to preschool.





WHO CAN ATTEND?

- Families with a child aged from 2 years with additional needs, or who are facing difficulties regarding their child attending an early learning service such as preschool or childcare.
- Children must not currently be attending an early learning service.
- Your family must be able to attend the program one morning each week.
- Siblings are welcome to attend.



HOW CAN THE PROGRAM HELP YOUR CHILD AND FAMILY?

Prep 4 Preschool playgroup is a gentle introduction to supporting and promoting your child's learning and development in a small group setting. You will have opportunities to meet other families and for your child to learn and play alongside other children. Your family will have support from staff to connect with a range of community supports, including preschools and childcare centres.



HOME LEARNING PROGRAM

The Early Intervention team have developed a Home Learning Program for families interested in being part of our playgroup but unable to attend a centre due to COVID-19. The home program includes guided play-based activities to engage your chilld and support learning at home, as well as online Zoom Group Times with our centre-based families, educators and therapists.
