

Cleaning Toys and Mouthed Toys Procedure

Preschool



Introduction	This procedure applies to all Learning Links staff. The term staff includes volunteers, students and contractors.
Strategies	<p>Step 1. Mothed toys are placed in a container clearly labelled “mouthed toys”.</p> <p>Step 2. Toys are cleaned either at rest time or end of the day. All toys that can be hand washed will be done so in the laundry sink in warm soapy water and rinsed thoroughly with clean water.</p> <p>Step 3. Cleaned toys are to be hung in the hosiery bags outside in the sun to air dry.</p>
